Chainsaw art comes to Victoria Park

Three trees which were creating problems in Victoria Park were turned into a new attraction when distinguished chainsaw carver Mick Burns visited in May 2004 and created 3 magical totem poles.

Friends of Victoria Park secured funding from the Stretford Area Board, and local school children from St Ann's Roman Catholic Infant School provided drawings and ideas of what animals, birds and insects they would like to see on them.
