Dear Parents / Carers,

Firstly, thank you all for your kind contributions for 'Be seen in Green Day'. Together we raised £189.00 which has been sent to the Royal Manchester Children's Hospital Charity, so that they can keep improving lives for children & families.

Winter is definitely on its way and with it comes the cold weather. Children need to wrap up warmly when they are outside and we encourage them to bring hats, scarves and gloves to school. Please make sure that everything is named as items always go missing and this will make it much easier for us to reunite lost property with its owner. Many children wear boots in the winter, which is a good idea. We do ask children who wear boots outside to change into their pumps when they are inside. It gives the boots a chance to dry out & more importantly, it can be uncomfortable for children to sit cross legged in boots on the carpet and in assembly.

We have a lovely opportunity to design a wooden sculpture for Victoria Park. Two of the current sculptures are worn and in need of replacing.
